

MDC *Blue Catfish* OPEN HOUSES

MDC is considering protective regulations to improve the quality of blue catfish on **Truman Reservoir** and **Lake of the Ozarks**. These waters have plenty of small blue catfish, but numbers of larger blues have declined. Protecting medium-size blue catfish will allow more to grow to larger sizes.

Regulation changes being considered include:

- Increase the daily limit from five to 10 blue catfish;
- Add a protected slot-length for medium-size blue catfish; and
- Allow the harvest of one or two blue catfish above the protected slot-length.

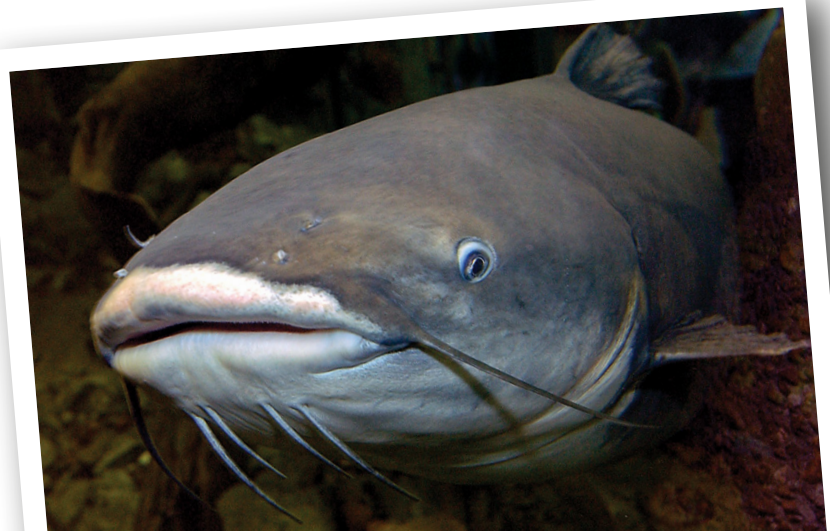
